TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. A written offer of a grant which specifies the amount of grant which you will receive upon satisfactory completion of the work must be obtained from Building Wildlife before work commences unless otherwise agreed.
2. The offer of the grant does not exclude the need for relevant consents/licences. All necessary consents/ licences – for example in respect of designated sites and protected species – need to be obtained prior to the work commencing.
3. Payment will only be made after the scheme has been completed to the satisfaction of Building Wildlife and receipts for approved expenses incurred and or submission of evidence eg photographs to confirm implementation.
4. Work to be completed and claims made within one calendar year of date of Grant Offer”.
4. If the applicant wilfully destroys or damages a feature which has been subject of grant aid within 10 years of the scheme’s date of completion, then Building Wildlife reserve the right to reclaim the grant in part or in full. Monitoring site visits will follow completion of the scheme.
5. Grant aid will not be offered for works required to satisfy a condition of planning consent.
5. All work carried out under the scheme must be carried out in accordance with the relevant British Standards or Best Practice.
